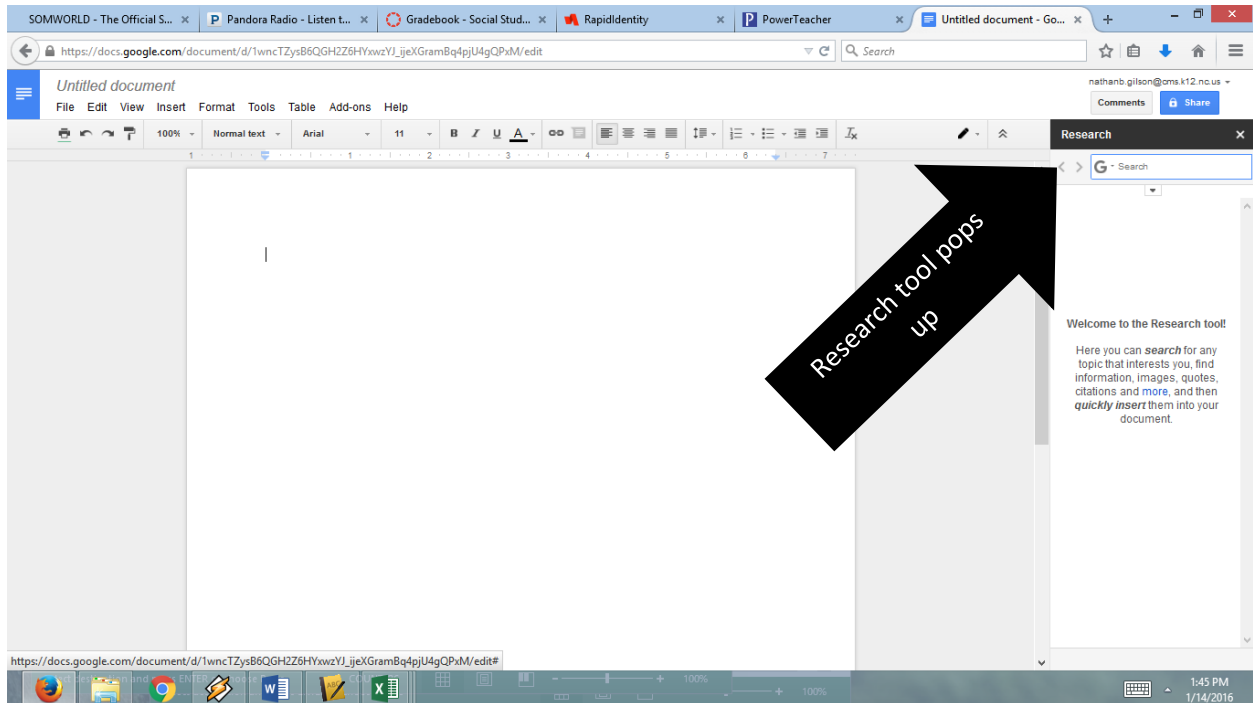


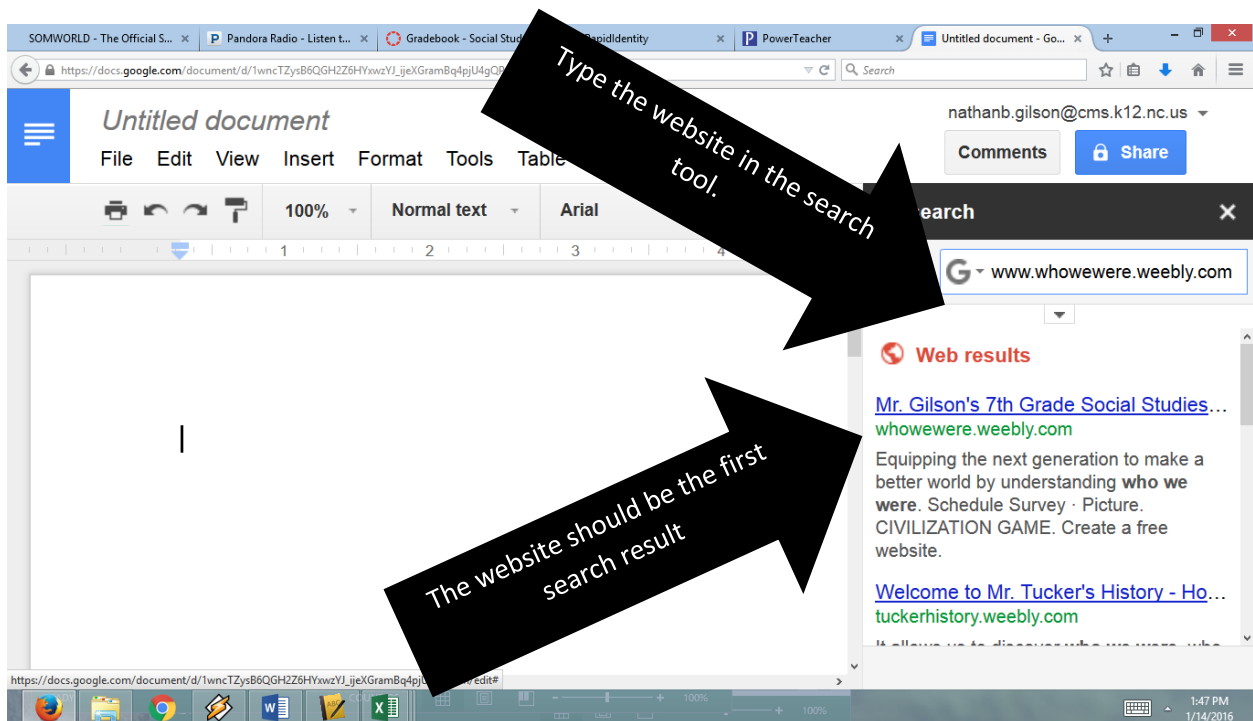
## 7. Cite your Research

If you cite in your paper where you got your information, you are giving credit to the author. This does not mean you can copy and paste everything they said, you still have to paraphrase and summarize. You should be doing Steps 6 and 7 together.

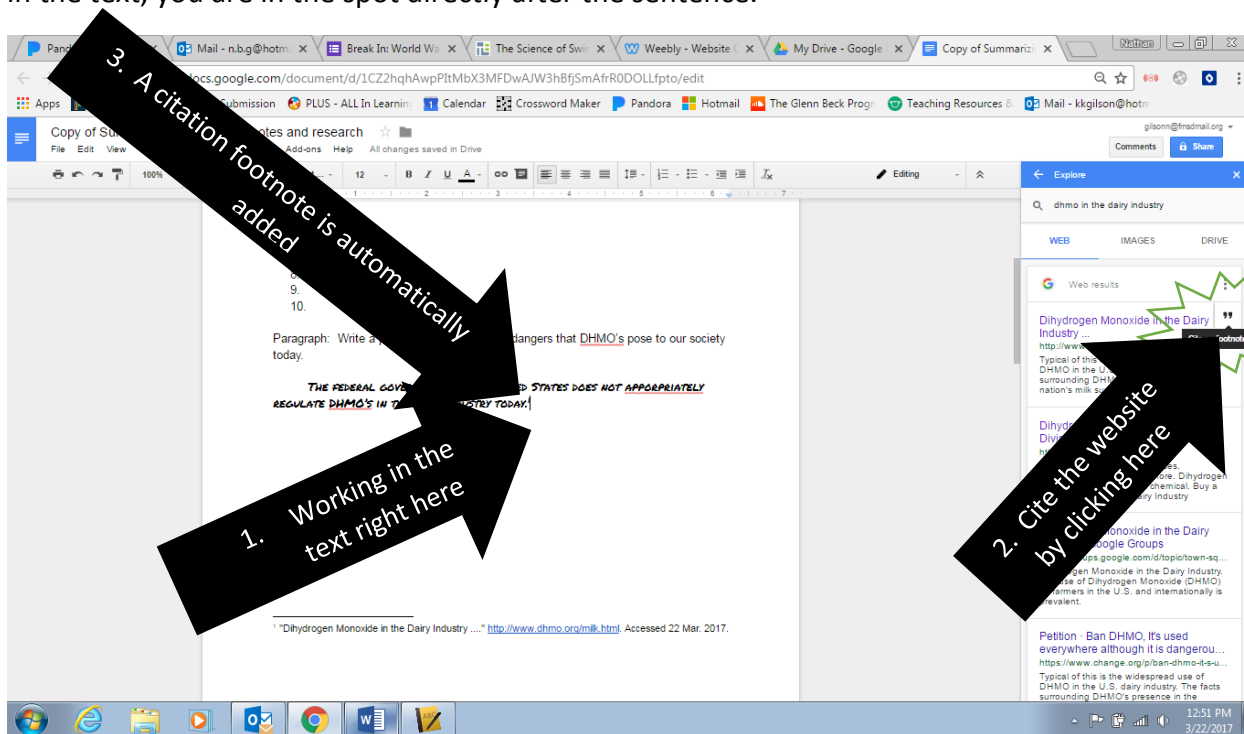
Step 1. Open your research paper google doc.  
Press ctrl+alt+shift+I or click on tools->research



Step 2. Type in the name of your source. In this case, you already have been provided with a resource list to choose from, so all you need to do is type in the name or website address in the search box.



Step 3. In your text, every fact that you got from that website needs to be cited. To cite the fact, just put your cursor over the website you want to cite and push the cite button. Make sure that in the text, you are in the spot directly after the sentence.



When you cite this way, it automatically adds a footnote with the website. You do not need to do any more work in the document.
