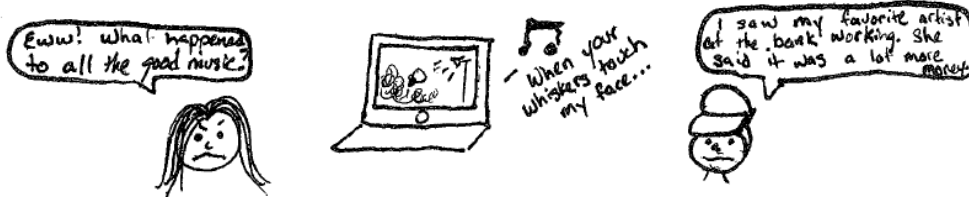




4-You don't have any good, new music to listen to, since everyone who is good at it has decided to go work at the bank to make
